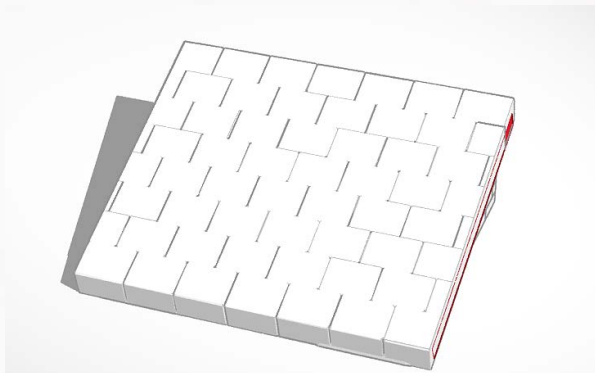


Platform Ramp
